OBJECTIVES

- Support people in learning Italian and also other languages
- Enhance plurilingualism, mother language as well as cultures of origin
- Encourage reading aloud
- Enhance institutions on the territory dedicated to interculture
- Support volunteering and social inclusion
- Assist in interchanging of ideas with different nationalities, genders, age and religions, all on library grounds

COLLECTIONS

- Novels of foreign authors translated in italian, in original language and / or parallel text for adults, kids and young adults

MAMMA LINGUA

The affiliated libraries promote the National project *Mamma Lingua*. Storie per tutti, nessuno escluso of the Associazione Italiana Biblioteche and the Oblate library. Working as a point of reference for Regione Toscana.

The project was created in collaboration with educational services of the City of Florence along with other state schools within the region. Suitcases full of books in Italian and other languages, silent books and books with symbols are borrowed from the libraries.

Mamma Lingua aims to highlight the value of bilingualism, mother language and promotion to read in families with a particular focus on preschoolers.
